

Subscriptions, memberships and other fees

A subscription to Gerontechnology journal is open to libraries, while for individuals and organisations access to Gerontechnology journal is a free service of the membership of the International Society for Gerontechnology. The journal is published quarterly and each issue contains at least 60 pages. Subscriptions and memberships always start in January. Cancelling a subscription or membership for the next year is possible until December 1 of the current year. Please inform us speedily of any change in (email) address. Hard copies of back issues may be ordered by mail at the e-mail address mentioned below. Please disclose your name, address, issues wanted, and way of payment. Cost depends on the age of the issue (Table 1).

Within a limited cluster of publicly-funded libraries, we allow free inter-library-loan of individual articles. As part of our policy to promote the exchange of scientific knowledge, we opened up most of our archive. Except for the two most recent volumes our journal is free to the public. During ISG membership or journal subscription, all issues are accessible online. An alert service for newly published issues has been installed.
